

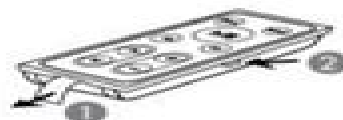

Starting the RF Wireless Remote Transmitter

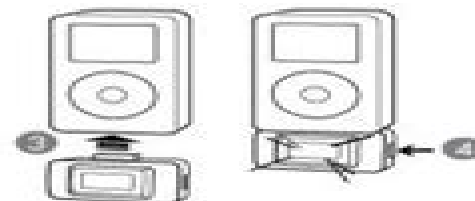
After you purchase the iPlus Wireless Remote,

- 2 Turn on the Power Switch on the side of transmitter.



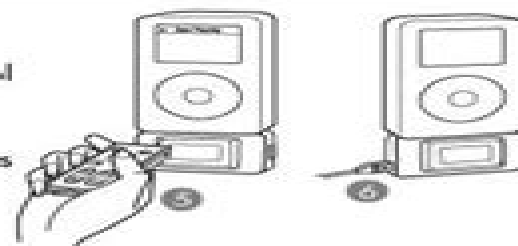
Connecting the Wireless Remote Receiver to the iPod

- 4 Press once the pairing button on side of unit, the receiver's light will begin to flash and "pairing" will automatically start. Once the light stops flashing, the Remote Transmitter has been found.



Operating Instructions:

- 5 Once your iPod is on, use the Transmitter (Remote Control) to control your iPod as if you were using the click wheel itself. (Hold 'Play/Pause' key for about 2 second will turn the iPod OFF)
- 6 By connecting a mini-USB cable (provided) to the side of the Wireless Remote Receiver, you can sync or re-charge the iPod.

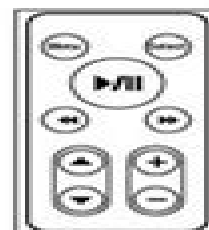
