To use this template, you need some basic knowledge about L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X, which can be easily found by google search with the key word `LaTeX`.

### 1.1 Main idea

After you downloaded the files, you may type your thesis by editing the three `.tex` files. You may first read the `sample-thesis.tex` and try to understand the command lines in the file. You can do that by comparing the `sample-thesis.tex` and `sample-thesis.pdf` files.

Note that you should use a plain text editor to edit the `.tex` file. You also need a L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>Xcompile in your computer. For windows user, you may use MikTex as a compiler and LEd (Latex Editor) as an editor. These are free software. UNIX system usually has a latex compiler.
